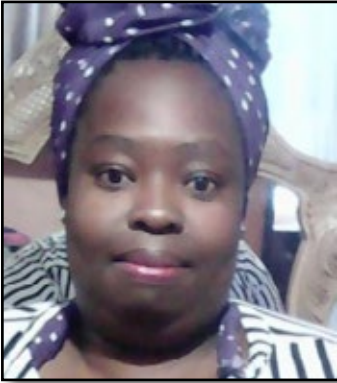


NOMINATIONS: National Working Group 2017/8

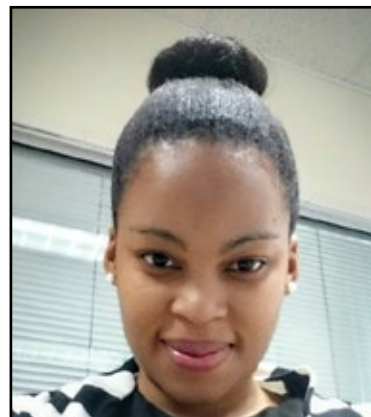
8. Moeketsi Monaheng
